

Features of admission to study in institutions of higher education of foreigners and stateless persons

1. Admission to higher education institutions of foreigners and stateless persons is carried out in accordance with the Laws of Ukraine "On Higher Education", "On the Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons", "On Foreign Ukrainians", "On the legal status of foreigners and stateless persons", "About foreign Ukrainians", "About refugees and persons in need of additional or temporary protection", by the Decree of the President of Ukraine of June 3, 1994 "About measures for development of economic cooperation of areas of Ukraine with adjacent areas of the Republic of Belarus and administrative-territorial units of the Republic of Moldova.", Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of September 11, 2013 № 684 "Some recruitment issues for foreigners and stateless persons", some issues of enrollment for foreigners and stateless persons", by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine of November 1, 2013 № 1541 "Some issues of organization of recruitment and training (internship) of foreigners and stateless persons", registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 25, 2013 under № 2004/24536.

2. Foreigners and stateless persons (hereinafter referred to as foreigners) may obtain higher education at the expense of natural persons and/or legal entities, unless otherwise stipulated by international treaties of Ukraine, the consent to the obligation of which has been granted by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, the legislation or the agreement between the institutions of higher education on international academic mobility.

Admission of foreigners to institutions of higher education for training at the expense of the state budget is carried out within the limits of quotas for foreigners (except foreigners and persons without citizenship, including foreign Ukrainians who permanently reside in Ukraine, persons who are recognized as refugees and persons who require additional protection).

Admission to study for foreign citizens and persons without citizenship is carried out on accredited educational programs.

3. Enrollment of foreign nationals to study at the cost of individuals and/or legal entities may be carried out by institutions of higher education:

- 1) two times per year, before and at the beginning of academic semesters (but not before 01 October and 01 March respectively), for obtaining the bachelor's and master's degrees;
- 2) during the year for studies in graduate school, doctoral studies.

The institution of higher education calculates the scores / scores of the applicant on the basis of the document on the previously achieved level of education and sets the minimum required number of scores / scores for admission from the general subjects for which the entrance examinations are conducted.

Enrollment of foreigners to the appropriate level of higher education is based on the results of the entrance examinations in the designated subjects and the language of study and on the basis of academic rights to continue the education, which are granted by the document on the achieved level of education in the country of his location, and taking into account the scores of success, which give the right to continue studies at the next level of higher education in accordance with the laws of the country which issued a document on the achieved level (level) of education.

4. All categories of foreigners who are enrolled in the program are enrolled in the PSACEA on the basis of the enrollment order. The confirmation of the fact of training can be a certificate, formed in the Unified State Electronic Database of Education.

5. Requirements of the PSACEA to the compliance of foreign applicants who have arrived in Ukraine for the purpose of study with the conditions of admission to the appropriate level of higher education, as well as the deadlines for accepting applications and documents, conducting

admission tests, creative competitions and admissions are specified in the Rules of Admission and are published on the official website of the PSACEA (pgasa.dp.ua).

6. Foreigners who are granted state scholarships under international treaties, national programs and other international obligations of Ukraine are admitted to the education within the established quotas for foreigners on the basis of referrals from the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

7. Foreigners arriving in Ukraine to participate in academic mobility programs or to obtain higher education under the educational programs mutually agreed between Ukrainian and foreign institutions of higher education, are accepted for studies taking into account the relevant contractual obligations of the relevant institutions of higher education.

8. Foreign Ukrainians who legally reside in Ukraine and whose status is certified by a certificate of foreign Ukrainians, have the same rights to receive education at the time of admission to the PSACEA, the Ukrainian citizens, with the exceptions established by the Constitution of Ukraine, the laws of Ukraine or international treaties ratified by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

Foreign Ukrainians, whose status is certified by the certificate of a foreign Ukrainian (except for persons permanently residing in Ukraine), may be enrolled for studies under the state order within the established quotas for foreigners on the basis of the subjects specified in the admission rules.

9. Foreigners and stateless persons, including Ukrainians abroad, who permanently reside in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees and persons in need of additional protection have the right to higher education on an equal footing with citizens of Ukraine, including at the expense of the state or local budget.
